INTERPRETATION OF PATTERN JOONG GUN (32 MOVEMENTS)

Joong Gun is named after the patriot An Joong Gun who assassinated Hiro Bumi Ito, the first Japanese governor-general of Korea, known as the man who played the leading part of the Korea Japan merger.

There are 32 movements in this pattern to represent Mr An's age when he was executed at Lui-Shung prison in 1910.
